TU AND UDK UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES

ONE BUILDING - TWO LIBRARIES

In the winter term 2004/2005 the university libraries of the Technische Universität Berlin (TU Berlin, Berlin Institute of Technology) and the Universität der Künste (UdK Berlin, Berlin University of the Arts) opened their doors in the VOLKSWAGEN-Haus in Fasanenstr. 88.

For the first time in its history the TU Berlin sought and found a sponsor - Volkswagen AG - to contribute to the construction costs. The Federal Government and the Technical University Berlin each committed € 25 million. The missing € 5 million were supplied by Volkswagen.

In the library you will find the latest technology, extensive holdings from science and engineering to art and design, a wide range of specialised and general literature databases, a large number of computer workstations and multimedia terminals as well as study carrels and group study rooms - in short ideal working conditions.

Our staff will gladly answer your questions and assist you individually.

Being the central information facility of the TU Berlin and the UdK Berlin we aim to provide students and faculty with a space which is all about obtaining resources for study and research. Last but not least, the library is a place for communication and encounters, too.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF THE TECHNISCHE UNIVERSITÄT (TU) BERLIN

The TU University Library is made up of the Central Library (Zentralbibliothek or „ZB“) and three department libraries (Bereichsbibliotheken). It gives you access to more than 2.3 million print and digital items pertaining to all subjects taught at the University. Basic holdings for other subjects are available.

CENTRAL LIBRARY IN THE VOLKSWAGEN-HAUS

Here you will find the following subject areas: general reference, natural sciences, technology, and humanities and social sciences. The central library also houses the University Press, the Thesis Office and the IVT (Technology Information Services).

DEPARTMENT LIBRARIES

The departmental libraries (Bereichsbibliotheken or BB) supply specialised literature for individual fields.

- BB Architecture and Art History
- BB Physics

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

- Architectural Museum (Collection of architectural drawings 19th and 20th century)
- German Horticultural Library (largest specialist library for horticultural literature in Germany)

UNIVERSITY ARCHIVES

The University Archives collect the records of the Technische Universität Berlin and make them accessible for public use.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF THE UNIVERSITÄT DER KÜNSTE (UDK) BERLIN

The UdK University Library provides literature and materials for the artistic and academic programs offered at the University. Due to its long and varied history the library possesses comprehensive and valuable collections of old stocks.

The holdings are divided into the following subject areas:

- art / architecture
- communication studies (including film and photography)
- design
- music / theatre
- education

In addition, UdK University Library offers sheet music in open shelving and an extensive collection of audiovisual media (videos, records, CDs, DVDs) in the Sondernutzungsbereich (Special Materials Area).
